

Lake Waubesa Bible Camp 2021 Covid-19 Camper Policies & Procedures

Our Goals:

- A positive, fun-filled camp experience for all
- Health and safety of all staff, campers, and families
- Ensure camp remains open throughout the summer

Before Camp: (We are relying on camper's family for the following, no documentation will be required)

- Monitor health for signs of Covid-19 in camper household for 14 days prior to camper arrival.
- Should a Covid-19 exposure occur or symptoms develop for camper or member of household, please obtain a Covid-19 negative test for camper 1-3 days prior to camper arrival.
- Camper should be fever-free for 24 hours prior to arrival regardless of cause of fever.
- Ensure the absence of new Covid-19 symptoms including fever on day of arrival.

Drop-off Procedures:

- Check-in and camper drop-off will occur at camper vehicle. Family will remain at vehicle.
- Staff will be masked during check-in. We ask that adult checking in camper also be masked.
- Camper's temperature will be taken upon arrival.
- For quicker check-in, complete all documents on your online parent dashboard prior to arrival.
Please remove any medications listed that camper will not be taking during their time at camp.
- Have medications (both prescription and over-the-counter) ready to turn in upon arrival.
- Camper and luggage will be accompanied to cabin to meet counselor and cabin mates.

Please note: Due to the increased risk of Covid-19 exposures associated with participating in/attending activities off-site, **campers will not be able to leave camp and return** during their week of overnight camp. Late arrivals on first day and early departures for the week are permitted.

During Camp: (Campers who develop a fever and/or Covid-19 symptoms during camp must return home.)

- Most meals, chapels, and activities will occur outside.
- Increased cleaning and sanitizing procedures will be followed.
- Hand sanitizer/handwashing opportunities will be encouraged or required throughout the day.
- Supplies and equipment procedures are in place to help minimize exposure to infection.
- **MASKS NOT REQUIRED** when outdoors, in camper cabin room or assigned bathroom, or while eating, sleeping, or participating in any water activities (inside or outside).
- **MASKS REQUIRED** for large group activities or chapels which are held indoors. Please note: While the majority of staff and speakers will be vaccinated, staff will always wear masks when campers are required to. (Camper lanyard with nametag and clip for mask will be provided.)
- Campers are welcome to wear masks at any time as they/parents desire.

Pick-up Procedures: **OVERNIGHT CAMP ENDS FRIDAYS at 2 PM**

- Campers and staff will be masked during pick-up. Masks may be removed for picture taking.
- Weather permitting, adult and family picking up camper are invited to park and proceed to basketball court/canteen to meet camper and counselor. We ask that all guests leaving their vehicles **wear a mask regardless of vaccination status.**
- For those who prefer not to wear a mask, camper and staff will come to your vehicle for pick-up.

After Camp: Please notify camp should camper be diagnosed with Covid-19 within 14 days of attending.
